

Question: Many people write to ask about the different aspects of Reincarnation, such as: How many lives do I have; Why am I in the life that I am in; Can I know what my past lives are? There are many books about past lives, and I have read that most people think they are the Reincarnation of someone famous in history, like Cleopatra or Napoleon. So, our question today is, what is the basic truth about Reincarnation?

Answer: This is an interesting question, and one that definitely needs to be explored because there are so many misconceptions about reincarnation. The first thing to say is that in order to understand the complexity of reincarnation selves, we really have to begin by delving into universal structure. To begin with, you also need to understand the premise that even though we experience time in a linear procession, actually that's just a matter of convenience and time does not really unfold in that manner. The timeline is spiral in nature and all points on the timeline, which is a consequence of the dimensional format we are in, takes place simultaneously. Thus, the idea that someone passes from one incarnation to another in succession is incorrect, although the concept of having reincarnational selves, or lifetimes that are somehow related to you, is indeed correct.

To better understand how this can be true, let's take a look at how the Soul is created and travels from one Universal Dimension to another. A Universal Dimension is where each Soul transmigrates after it is created by Source energy. That Soul then incarnates in various forms, physical and spiritual, in that Universal Dimension in order to have experiences that will promote Soul growth, allowing it raise its frequency and, eventually, Ascend to the next Universal Dimension. Independent lifetimes are created by each Soul within a Universal Dimension in much the same way the God Force or Source energy first creates each Soul. The difference here is that each lifetime created in a Universal Dimension cannot exist outside of that dimension whereas each Soul that has been cast can in fact continue on through all Twelve Universal Dimensions.

We add to this the fact that higher dimensions can generally see lower dimensions but lower dimensions cannot see higher dimensions. What I mean by this is that the dimensions overlap and so they occupy essentially the same space, even though they are segmented by virtue of frequency and vibration.

So as an example, the first Universal Dimension, is the realm of planetary Beings, among other things, and you might also refer to it as the realm of the Mineral Kingdom. Thus, dense physical matter, such as rocks, mountains, mountain ranges and grains of sand, are all first dimensional physical Beings. That density subsides as a Being rises through the Universal Dimensions.

When a soul is cast out from the highest Universal Dimension, which is the 12th Universal Dimension, it will be cast out (by "cast out," we do not infer a bad thing, but simply mean that which is created and compelled into existence by All That Is, the God Force if you will), the soul then transmigrates to a Universal Dimension, usually beginning with the First Universal Dimension. In that way, a Soul incarnates in the First Universal Dimension

through numerous lifetimes and in various forms, physical and spiritual. This then is where we get the concept of reincarnation, meaning many lives.

So, when a Soul is first created in the Twelfth Universal Dimension, it transmigrates across the twelfth sub-level of a Universe Dimension, because the Universal Dimension itself has compatibility and is, in a way, linked with the sublevel that corresponds to it. Thus, the Twelfth Universal Dimension has association with the Twelfth sublevel of every Universal Dimension, and because the Twelfth Universal Dimension is considered the realm of All That Is, or God, every Universal Dimension has a link with that God Force through the Twelfth sublevel of whatever the dimension is.

Now to begin with, the Soul traverses to the First Universal Dimension through the Twelfth Sublevel of that Dimension, where it will reside for the duration of its existence and learning experiences within the First Universal Dimension. From that 12th sub-level then, it will then create or “incarnate” into various lifetimes that will traverse through all the sublevels of that Dimension, per the Soul’s instructions and goals for growth within the Universal Dimension. The various incarnations and lives of that Soul within the Dimension are essentially cells within the body of that Soul in the particular Universal Dimension. These are the reincarnations that we are discussing here.

A Soul that is in the First Universal Dimension, coordinating lifetimes within that Universal Dimension from its position in the 12th sub-level of the Dimension, will “cast out” or create lifetimes through Beings it incarnated focused in various places for various purposes throughout all the sublevels of that particular Universal Dimension.

As an example, in this case, let's choose the incarnation of a mountain range. As we said, a rock is a First Universal Dimension Being. So, a Soul that has transmigrated from the highest universal dimension to the First Universal Dimension may create one, two or thousands of lives (incarnations) in that First Universal Dimension as a rock Being. That rock Being will then comprise a mountain range, just as a grain of sand when unified with others creates a beautiful sandy beach, each of which represents a Being or incarnation of the Soul, with validity and purpose. These lifetimes in the Universal Dimension can exist for millennia, because, as we said, there is really essentially no linear time in the manner we use to measure time.

It is only after a Soul has experienced enough lifetimes to achieve the growth it is seeking within a particular universal dimension, and after each of the Beings it has created have passed through all the sublevels and forms available to it in the Universal Dimension, that a Soul is ready to reintegrate all of its (re)incarnations into itself. This occurs when all the incarnations it has created in the Universal Dimension reunite in the Twelfth Sublevel of the Dimension. At that particular point, when all those lifetimes, and the energy and consciousness they now represent, are successfully reintegrated with the Soul, the Soul is said to “Ascend” to the next Universal Dimension. That is the process of Ascension that is much spoken of, a process that is essentially Universal process of the evolution of the Soul.

Now, to facilitate this discussion, we are going to skip ahead directly to the Third Universal Dimension, which is the dimension that we are currently incarnated in, to explain how physical Human Beings are created as entities in the lifetime of the Soul, which has Ascended to the Third Universal Dimension. The Soul, having completed numerous lifetimes, over eons and eons of linear time in the First Universal Dimension, and after graduating and completing its many lifetimes in the Second Universal Dimension, ultimately graduates to the Third Universal Dimension.

It is in the Third Universal Dimension that a Soul has the consciousness from its eons of experience in the lower Universal Dimensions, is able to create lifetimes in physical form. Those Souls that are members of the Human Angelic Soul race will incarnate as physical Human Beings at the Third Sublevel of the Third Universal Dimension.

How a Soul does this is a very interesting process. To be clear, the Soul creates thousands and thousands of lifetimes within almost every Universal Dimension in various forms. It does so by creating what we have identified as “Wheels of Creation.”

These Wheels of Creation can be comprised of any number of lifetimes. In general, these Wheels will consist of between 5 to 24 or more individual lifetimes, all of which are interrelated with each other either by virtue of a common life mission, or by virtue of the need for karmic balancing, within each Wheel of Creation. Souls can have hundreds of Wheels of Creation it creates within a Universal Dimension, and those lifetimes can exist independently at any point of the linear timeline within the Dimension. This is the reason why lifetimes, even though they are all transpiring simultaneously because of the true nature of time, appear to be happening at different points and in different eras on the historical time.

In addition to this, these lifetimes can also be cycling through any higher Sublevel of the Universal Dimension. So, whereas, for example, one lifetime might be enjoying physical life at the Third Sublevel in this or that time period, another might be existing in its spiritual body at the Fifth, Sixth, Seventh or Eighth Sublevel of the Dimension, which are considered the higher Astral planes of existence.

This is also interesting because Wheels of Creation can have their own objectives, and individual entities or lifetimes (reincarnations) on a particular Wheel can all have their own life mission and purpose, but they can also secondarily be tied into the mission of all the other lifetimes on their Wheel of Creation. Close association and commonality is often felt between lifetimes on the same Wheel. This is why situations and traits from one life on the Wheel can be felt by others that are associated with it, and this is the reason you have reincarnation memories or strong emotional relationship with other reincarnations that are related to you by virtue of your Wheel of Creation.

As an example, if there is karma created in one life incarnation on the Wheel, in another time period on your Wheel of Creation, that karma or influence, as an energetic happening in that other life, can bleed through to all the other lifetimes that are also on that particular Wheel of Creation. Karma does not always need to be balanced by the individual or person

who generates it, and is often dealt with and balanced by another lifetime on the same Wheel. Because of this, an important part of consciousness growth is the realization that everything you do not only has an effect on you, but potentially also on another lifetime or reincarnation associated with you by way of the Wheel of Creation you, as an entity of your Soul, are on.

The manner in which the Soul's Wheels are constructed allows an understanding as to why many have the impression they have lived in different time periods, or why certain phobias, that have no basis in current lifetime events, exists. It also serves as a main reason certain events and people come and go into your life, as you may be working to balance out karma generated by a fellow lifetime that exists with you on a Wheel of Creation.

Wheels of Creation are created by a Soul within the Universal Dimension and there can be hundreds of Wheels generated, with each Wheel containing many associated lifetimes. The number or complexity of lifetimes is dependent only on the Soul itself, which is based on its consciousness, dexterity and goals. Ultimately, the purpose of any lifetime on any Wheel is the growth of your Soul, through continual elevation of its vibrational resonance and consciousness, as it journeys back through each Universal Dimension on its way to the source of origination, All That Is.

Now with respect to each lifetime a Soul creates on a Wheel of Creation, these can take place at any point of the timeline of that current Dimension. When a particular entity, or reincarnation on a Wheel is accomplished, and that person passes away, they pass into higher sub-levels of the Universal Dimension.

Using our Third Universal Dimension as an example, our physical existence and experiences are focused within the Third Sublevel of the Third Universal Dimension. When you pass from physical life, you retain who you are and your identity, and your energetic or etheric body continues on to the Fourth Dimensional Sublevel, ultimately passing through this and continuing on in first the lower, and then the higher, Astral planes.

As the energetic body that is you, without physical composition, progresses higher and higher through these Astral Sublevels of the Dimension, experiences become more and more metaphysical, or spiritual, in nature. As we said, ultimately, the goal of every single lifetime of every single Wheel of Creation is to pass through all higher Sublevels of the Dimension, retaining the consciousness it has gathered and then reintegrating with the Soul that created it in the Twelfth Sublevel of the Universal Dimension.

Many will prefer the simplified version of reincarnation, which has been passed down to you as one lifetime after another until you reach completion. Though many will prefer to entertain a more complex model that departs from the egocentric view of who and what they are, the more complex version that is aligned with Universal structure is truer to the actual progress you make, together with your Soul, as you traverse all the Universal Dimension and all the Dimensional Sublevels in between.

The Wheels of incarnation we have discussed here objectively link you with your Soul, and your Soul with the God force or Creator. Ascension is not only the evolution of you and your Soul, it is the evolutionary proves of every conscious entity in the Universe, if not the Universe itself.

Ultimately, when a lifetime or reincarnation, reintegrates with its Soul at the highest Sub-level of a Universal Dimension, it brings with it its identity, its knowledge and its purpose, in much the same way a cell in your body is a part of the whole entire body but retains its own individuality and function within each person. Each life is an integral part of its Soul that contributes to the overall growth of its Soul, which allows the Soul to participate in the grand process of Ascension.

This is probably the best way to begin the conversation of reincarnation and the purpose of your Soul. In the future, we can add to this discussion truths about the higher Universal Dimensions, the Astral Sublevels of each Dimension, and what happens specifically for each person as they pass from physical life into the Astral planes, a fascinating process each will at some point experience.

Suffice to say for now, that this is the true kernel of how reincarnation works, and what it is all about. This stands in direct conflict with the current widely held assumption that reincarnation is where you become someone else in an endless linear procession, leaving you wondering if you may have been Cleopatra in a past life.

On the contrary, you remain you always, but by virtue of karmic balance and your Soul, you are closely connected to all the other lifetimes, or reincarnations, it creates on the Wheel of Creation of which you are part. This further connects you, individually and intimately, to your Soul's growth, as well as the evolutionary process of Universal Ascension, as you and your Soul journey through the Universe together forever.
